

SPECIAL REGISTRATION FOR NON IMMIGRANTS

National Security Entry–Exit Registration System (NSEERS)

Under [NSEERS Special Registration](#), non-immigrants from certain countries are required to:

1. Register with immigration authorities at a U.S. Port of Entry (see below for list)
2. Report to the DHS for additional in-person interviews, if instructed by the port of entry official.
3. Notify immigration authorities of changes of residential address by updating addresses in [WSU METRO](#).
4. Use specially [designated ports](#) when leaving the United States and report in person to an immigration officer at the port on their departure date.

As of December 2003, male citizens or nationals of the following countries **must comply** with [special registration](#):

Los Angeles International Airport:

Special Registrants must report to the arrival level, South End at Tom Bradley International Terminal) at Los Angeles International Airport. The departure office is located next to the Interline Connecting Baggage Area (INSPASS Enrollment Center). The address is 380 World Way, Arrival Level, Los Angeles, CA 90045, (310)568-7500, hours of operation: 7:00 am to 12:00 Midnight.
